

Hostel Rules

During their stay at the PIFD Hostel, the female students will be required to abide by certain rules, failing which they risk expulsion both from the hostel and the Institute. For this purpose, they are required to comply with the following Hostel Regulations:

- a) Only regular students of PIFD are eligible for admission in the PIFD Hostel. However, in exceptional cases, the Alumni may be permitted to stay in the Hostel for a short duration with the Authorities' approval.
- b) Students taking admission in the hostel shall submit an application or an admission form in duplicate, duly completed, along with three passport size photographs to the hostel warden, who will be responsible for allotting rooms.
- c) Allotment of rooms shall be made after the candidates have produced the payment receipt from the designated bank. They will pay mess fee by 6th of every month.
- d) The applicants will have to furnish a written guarantee from their guardians, holding them responsible for the payment of the hostel dues, in case of their wards failing to make the payment. A written guarantee shall also be provided by the resident and his/her guardian regarding observance of all hostel rules.
- e) Students/boarders are required to deposit the security deposit PKR. 2,000/- as well as monthly charges for the entire semester in advance at the time of admission to the hostel. The hostel charges will be fixed by the hostel Committee of PIFD from time to time.
- f) Residents shall be under the disciplinary control of the Warden.
- g) Residents shall sign a receipt of Hostel property in their rooms and shall be responsible for any loss or damage.
- h) Residents are not allowed to change their rooms of their own accord, or allow a guest to stay overnight with them.
- i) Residents shall not be allowed to keep pets in their rooms.
- j) Residents should not disturb their fellow residents by playing radio, music player or any such instruments at a high volume, or by any other discomfort.
- k) Silence hour should be maintained strictly after 9:30 p.m. in the hostel so that residents can devote their time to studies.
- l) No societies shall be formed and no meetings shall be held within the premises of the hostel.
- m) Residents are not allowed to give tips or make any other kind of payment to the sweepers, bearer, or any other employees of the hostel.
- n) Residents are advised in their own interest not to keep expensive articles or valuables in their rooms.
- o) Residents are prohibited from keeping any kinds of arms, ammunition or intoxicants in their possession. Non-observance of this rule shall be severely dealt with. Residents who are found in intoxicated condition will be expelled from the hostel on a 24 hours' notice.
- p) Residents committing serious offences such as violation of the rules and regulations of

the hostel, holding meetings or collection of subscription without prior approval of the Authorities and non-payment of dues shall be subjected to disciplinary action, extending up to expulsion from the Hostel/PIFD depending upon the seriousness of the offence.

- q) Residents once expelled from the hostel shall not be admitted again or allowed to stay in the hostel.
- r) Residents should leave the hostel within one week after the declaration of their last examination results and report their departure to the Authorities after getting clearance.
- s) Residents shall be under obligation to comply to all the rules and regulations that may be enforced in the Hostel from time to time.
- t) All residents should be in the hostel by 09:00 p.m. in summer and by 08:00 in winter. Residents wishing to stay outside the hostel (from 09:00 pm till late night for attending some function) must write the necessary particulars in the overnight register if they so desire. A suitable fine will be imposed on the boarders habitual of coming late.
- u) Female visitors shall be received only in the guest room and under no circumstances female visitors will be allowed to enter individual rooms.
- v) All residents should ensure that the persons visiting them fill in the necessary particulars in the register. No private parties or functions can be arranged by individuals or groups without the prior permission of the Hostel Warden.
- w) Residents are advised not to enter into any conflict with the employees of the hostel. The complaints against the hostel staff should be brought in to the notice of the Hostel Warden.
- x) No resident(s) shall be allowed to take any crockery into his/her room without prior permission of the Mess Manager.
- y) No resident shall open the door of another resident's room without his/her permission.
- z) All cases of illness should be immediately reported to the Hostel Warden, who shall make necessary arrangements for medical help.
