

**AN ORDINANCE  
AMENDING SECTION 149.02 OF THE CODIFIED  
ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAGRIN FALLS TO  
MODIFY THE CLOTHING ALLOWANCE FOR POLICE AND  
FIRE EMPLOYEES.**

WHEREAS, Section 149.02 provides for the payment of an annual clothing allowance to certain employees of the Police and Fire Departments; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to amend Section 149.02 to change the uniform maintenance payments to the Fire Prevention Officer and the Fire Chief.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAGRIN FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:**

SECTION 1. That existing Section 149.02, Clothing Allowance for Police and Fire Employees, of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls be, and the same is hereby amended to read and provide, in its entirety, as follows:

**“149.02 CLOTHING ALLOWANCE FOR POLICE AND FIRE EMPLOYEES.**

- (a) Every regular member of the Police Department and every part-time member of the Police Department who works on a regularly scheduled basis shall wear such uniforms or clothing as directed and approved by the Chief of Police.
- (b) Police and Fire Department maintenance and clothing allowances shall, beginning January 1, 2013, be as follows:

<u>Position</u>	<u>Maintenance Allowance per year</u>	<u>Clothing Allowance Per calendar year</u>
Full time police member Employed with the Village for more than 2 years)	\$100.00	\$600.00
New police hires (during first 2 years of service)	Pursuant to Subsection (e) below.	
Part time police members (working 32 hours per week regularly)	\$100.00	\$600.00

Part time police members (working less than 32 hours per week regularly after having served a minimum of 100 hours excluding Dog Warden and Matrons)	\$ 40.00	\$260.00
Full time police-radio dispatcher	\$ 70.00	\$380.00
Full time police clerk	\$ 70.00	\$380.00
Fire Chief	\$100.00	\$150.00

- (c) New hires who separate from the service of the Police Department for any reason, except termination, within their first year, shall reimburse the Village for the cost of the initial uniform furnished to them.
- (d) Fire Prevention Officer shall be issued an initial uniform not to exceed the cost of one hundred seventy-five dollars (\$175.00). Each Fire Prevention Officer shall then receive a uniform maintenance allowance of six hundred dollars (\$600.00) each calendar year thereafter.
- (e) A list of uniform apparel and other gear required for one police officer shall be approved by the Mayor and kept in the office of the Police Department. The Village shall issue an initial uniform, complete with all of the apparel and other gear required and included on the list approved by the Mayor, to each new police hire.
- (f) An employee shall receive only one maintenance allowance per year.”

SECTION 2. That existing Section 149.02, Clothing Allowance for Police and Fire Employees, of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls, and any other ordinance in conflict herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements, including Chapter 114 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls.

SECTION 4. That in accordance with Section 113.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls, public notice of this Ordinance shall be given by posting a copy thereof for not less than fifteen (15) days in the Village Hall.

SECTION 5. That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health and safety of this Village and for the


further reason that this Ordinance must be immediately effective so that the Village may timely provide for the payment of clothing allowances for certain members of the Police and Fire Departments; wherefore, provided it receives the requisite number of affirmative votes of all members elected to Council, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its passage by this Council and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force after the earliest period allowed by law.
