

**AN ORDINANCE
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN
AGREEMENT WITH BURTON SCOT CONTRACTORS FOR
THE 2015 PAVEMENT REPAIR PROGRAM, AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Village advertised for bids for the Village's 2015 Pavement Repair Program and received two sealed bids on September 24, 2015, at which time the bids were opened and read; and

WHEREAS, the Village Engineer has determined that Burton Scot Contractors submitted the lowest bid and has recommended that the Village award a contract to Burton Scot Contractors for the 2015 Pavement Repair Program; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines that Burton Scot Contractors has submitted the lowest and best bid for the 2015 Pavement Repair Program; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to authorize the Mayor to execute an agreement with Burton Scot Contractors for the 2015 Pavement Repair Program in the amount of \$52,475.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAGRIN FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Burton Scot Contractors in the amount \$52,475.00 for the 2015 Pavement Repair Program, being the lowest and best bid received, is hereby accepted and approved and the Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into and execute on behalf of the Village a proper contract with Burton Scot Contractors for the 2015 Pavement Repair Program.

SECTION 2. The Finance Director is authorized to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the costs of the contract authorized in Section 1 of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements, including Chapter 114 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls.

SECTION 4. That in accordance with Section 113.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls, public notice of this Ordinance shall be given by posting a copy thereof for not less than fifteen (15) days in the Village Hall.

SECTION 5. That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health and safety of this Village and for the further reason that this Ordinance must be immediately effective so that the 2015 Pavement Repair Program may begin during the appropriate season; wherefore, provided it receives the requisite number of affirmative votes of all members elected to Council, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its passage by this Council and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force after the earliest period allowed by law.


