CHAGRIN DOCUMENTARY FILM FESTIVAL

Mary Ann Ponce announced that the "Best of the Fest" film series will be held at the Chagrin Falls Public Library on Sunday, February 10, 2013 and Mondays and Thursdays throughout February at the Orange Senior Center. There is no charge to attend. She mentioned that they are going to be forming a partnership with the Chagrin Valley Rotary, who has a history of raising funds for international causes. They will be hosting their large fund raiser during the film festival. They are also planning a "Run to the Red Carpet" to benefit Leukemia Lymphoma, which will be held on the Sunday before the film festival. She also mentioned that they have four or five documentaries from the Sundance Film Festival that they would love to screen here.


PUBLIC ART GUIDELINES
