AN ORDINANCE
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN
AGREEMENT WITH BURTON SCOT CONTRACTORS LLC
TO PERFORM THE 2011 ROAD PROGRAM, AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village has advertised for bids for the 2011 Road Program, which provides for pavement repair of Village Roads; and

WHEREAS, the administration has recommended that the aforesaid 2011 Road Program contract be awarded to Burton Scot Contractors LLC, which submitted the lowest and best bid received by the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAGRIN FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Burton Scot Contractors LLC in an amount not to exceed one hundred ninety-two thousand eight hundred forty-seven dollars and zero cents (\$192,847.00) to perform the 2011 Road Program, and Council hereby finds and determines that the contract authorized herein is being awarded on the lowest and best bid.

SECTION 2. That sufficient funds are hereby appropriated to pay for the contract authorized herein.

SECTION 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements, including Chapter 114 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls.

SECTION 4. That in accordance with Section 113.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls, public notice of this Ordinance shall be given by posting a copy thereof for not less than fifteen (15) days in the Village Hall.

SECTION 5. That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health and safety of this Village and for the further reason that this Ordinance must be immediately effective so that the Village may commence the road program and complete it before inclement weather arrives; wherefore, provided it receives the requisite number of affirmative votes of all members elected to Council, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its passage by this Council and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force after the earliest period allowed by law.




