

**AN ORDINANCE
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN
AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION AND TAKE ANY OTHER ACTION
NECESSARY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE BULK
PURCHASING OF ROAD SALT FOR THE 2014-2015
WINTER SEASON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT") has created a consortium of governmental entities to band together to purchase rock salt, for the purposes of controlling ice and snow on Ohio's roads; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines that it is appropriate for the Village of Chagrin Falls to purchase rock salt with other organizations, through ODOT, in order to take advantage of economies of scale.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAGRIN FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be, and hereby is, authorized to enter into an agreement with ODOT in order to participate in bulk purchasing of rock salt, and to enter into any additional agreements, or take any further necessary actions, to implement the road salt program(s) sponsored by ODOT for the 2014-2015 winter season.

SECTION 2. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements, including Chapter 114 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls.

SECTION 3. That in accordance with Section 113.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls, public notice of this Ordinance shall be given by posting a copy thereof for not less than fifteen (15) days in the Village Hall.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health and safety of this Village and for the further reason that this Ordinance must be immediately effective for the reason that in order to obtain salt pursuant to the ODOT contract, immediate action is necessary because ODOT has set a April 8, 2014, deadline for submission; wherefore, provided it receives the requisite number of affirmative votes of all members elected to Council, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its passage by this Council and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take



Participating Political Subdivisions are intended beneficiaries under these contracts and are real parties in interest with the capacity to sue and be sued in their own name without joining the state of Ohio, Ohio Department of Transportation. By signing and returning this agreement, you will be bound to participate in these contracts (as applicable to each Political Subdivision) during the upcoming Summer fill up and winter season, upon award of the contract by ODOT to a successful vendor. A participating Political Subdivision cannot change its position during this contract period. Termination of participation is effective upon the expiration date of each contract. Failure of a Political Subdivision to purchase its requirements from the awarded vendor or comply with the terms of these contracts may invalidate participation for the following summer or winter season contracts.

This Participation Agreement must be received by the Ohio Department of Transportation, Office of Contracts, Purchasing Services prior to the mailing of the Invitation to bid. Political subdivisions will be required to submit a new participation agreement form every year, indicating storage capacity and stating salt needs for the contract period.
