BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Chagrin Falls,
State of Ohio:

SECTION 2: That all expenditures of the Village of Chagrin Falls within the year ending December 31, 2014, shall be made within and with the appropriation herein before provided.

SECTION 3: That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to draw warrants on the Village depository for any portion of the amounts within the above named appropriation whenever claims are presented, property approved by the head of the department for which the indebtedness incurred.

SECTION 4: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and related to the passage of this legislation were adopted in lawful meetings of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in compliance with all legal requirements, including Chapter 114 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls.

SECTION 5: That in accordance with Section 113.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls, public notice of this Ordinance shall be given by posting a copy thereof for not less than fifteen (15) days in the Village Hall.

SECTION 6: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the ordinance will provide the means for payment of salaries, wages, and other vital obligations of the Village for its continued and uninterrupted operation, and provided it receives two-thirds vote of all members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor, or otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


