

**A RESOLUTION
DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO RENEW AN EXISTING
CURRENT EXPENSE TAX LEVY AND REQUESTING THE
CUYAHOGA COUNTY FISCAL OFFICER TO CERTIFY THE
TOTAL CURRENT TAX VALUATION OF THE VILLAGE
AND THE DOLLAR AMOUNT OF REVENUE THAT WOULD
BE GRANTED BY THAT RENEWAL LEVY, AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the electors of the Village of Chagrin Falls on November 4, 2008, approved a five and one-half (5.5) mill levy for current expenses of the Village for a period of five (5) years, the last collection of which levy shall occur in calendar year 2014; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds it necessary, in order to provide the Village with necessary funds for its operations and other current expenses, to renew said five and one-half (5.5) mill, levy in accordance with Revised Code Sections 5705.19 and 5705.191; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Division (B) of Section 5705.03 of the Revised Code, as amended by Am. Sub. S.B. No. 201, effective December 21, 1998, in order to submit the question of replacement of the existing five and one-half (5.5) mill tax levy upon the tax list and duplicate for a continuing period of five (5) years commencing with a levy on the 2014 tax list and duplicate for distribution to the Village in calendar year 2015 for the purpose of supporting this, Council must request that the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer certify (i) the total current tax valuation of the Village, and (ii) the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the levy; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Division (B) of Section 5705.03 of the Revised Code, upon receipt of a certified copy of a resolution of this Council declaring the necessity of the tax, stating its purpose, stating whether it is an additional levy, a renewal or a replacement of an existing tax, noting the Section of the Ohio Revised Code pursuant to which its submission to the electors is authorized, and requesting County Fiscal Officer certification, the County Fiscal Officer is to certify the total current tax valuation of the Village and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the proposed levy.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE
OF CHAGRIN FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:**

SECTION 1. That this Council declares that it is necessary to renew, for a period of five (5) years, at a rate not exceeding five and five tenths (5.50) mills for each one dollar of valuation, for the purpose of current expenses, and that it intends to submit the question of the operational levy to the electors at the general election on November 5, 2013, as authorized by Sections 5705.19 and 5705.191 of the Revised Code.

SECTION 2. That this Council requests the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer to certify both (i) the total current tax valuation of the Village, and (ii) the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the five and five tenths (5.50) mills for the Chagrin Falls operating levy specified in

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Section 1.

SECTION 3. That the Clerk of this Council is authorized and directed to deliver promptly to the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer a certified copy of this Resolution.

SECTION 4. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements, including Chapter 114 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls.

SECTION 5. That in accordance with Section 113.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls, public notice of this Resolution shall be given by posting a copy thereof for not less than fifteen (15) days in the Village Hall.

SECTION 6. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the inhabitants of the Village and for the further reason that preparations must be made in a timely fashion in order to have this matter placed on the ballot in November; wherefore, provided it receives two-thirds of the vote of all members of Council elected thereto, this resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor, or otherwise it shall take from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
