The meeting was called to order at 7:15 p.m. by Chairman Steven Patton.

PHASE II STORMWATER REGULATIONS - CRWP MOU

The Small MS4 Stormwater Program overview was reviewed and discussed. The six main points are public education and outreach, public participation/involvement, illicit discharge detection and eliminations, construction site runoff control, post-construction runoff control, and pollution prevention/good housekeeping.

Christina Znidarsic, from the Chagrin River Watershed Partners, explained how they assist communities in the management of stormwater runoff and related resource management issues.

Moved by Mr. Patton, seconded by Mrs. Evans that we recommend to Council that we pass tonight's legislation in regard to entering into a memorandum of understanding with the Chagrin River Watershed Partners. The motion carried unanimously.

EAST COTTAGE STREET SEWER REPAIR

Mr. Himes explained that there is a storm sewer that runs on an easement between Summit Street and Cottage Street. It is an old clay pipe that is in relatively good shape although the joints are failing. The cost of lining it was about \$18,000 so they are looking at doing joint repairs. He does not have a quote for the joint repairs yet.
