Every seventh grade civics teacher should be intimately aware of the Civics EOC Item Specification Booklet. This is a critical document for civics teachers. This booklet contains information on benchmark clarifications, content limits, content focus, etc. It is important to remember that this document was written for the persons writing the test questions. The civics textbooks that are currently in use may have been published prior to the release of the Item Specification Booklet. Make sure you have this document to reference daily as you teach the civics benchmarks.
