

**VILLAGE OF CHAGRIN FALLS
STREETS AND SIDEWALKS COMMITTEE
July 24, 2017**

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Chairman Brett Berkobein.

BID REVIEW - 2017 PAVEMENT PROGRAM

Mr. Berkobein said this is for the curb on Bell Street, the retaining walls on Solon Road and Riverside Park, and the paving of Carriage Stone, Willow Lane, and Monticello. The low bid came in at \$388,804.90 from Carron Asphalt Paving, Inc.

Moved by Ms. Rogoff, seconded by Mr. Mitchell to recommend this to Council. Carried. Ayes: Berkobein, Mitchell, Rogoff. Nays: None.

BID REVIEW - PEDESTRIAN SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS

Mr. Lannon explained that this is for the installation of leading pedestrian interval traffic signals at four intersections in the downtown. All traffic lights will be red when the pedestrian signal is on walk. They received only one bid and it was from Signal Service Company at 39,800.00. The village received a grant for these improvements.

Moved by Ms. Rogoff, seconded by Mr. Mitchell to recommend this to Council. Carried. Ayes: Berkobein, Mitchell, Rogoff. Nays: None.

WALTERS ROAD

Mr. Lannon said the road is narrow but they are not going to do a whole lot about the width. They are improving it by the width of a concrete gutter section and by moving the catch basins out from where they are now. It needs a water main and the sanitary sewer has had a history of problems. The final plan is to fill that deep enough to eliminate the Hickory Hill lift station.

Mr. Lannon said the plan was for a sidewalk on the north side of the street but by the time they had the program figured out and out to bid it was getting to be too late in the year. They received one bid and it was substantially higher than the estimate. The recommendation is to rebid this next year.
