

Easy Single Crochet PICC Line Bandage Cover ~ Pattern for Knots of Love

A peripherally inserted central catheter (PICC or PIC line) line is a thin, flexible tube that is inserted into a vein in the upper portion of the arm. It is a form of intravenous access that can be used for a prolonged period of time (e.g. for long chemotherapy regimens, extended antibiotic therapy, or total parenteral nutrition).



Materials:

Yarn from approved list

G hook

Tapestry needle, if desired

DIRECTIONS:

Loosely ch 30. Being careful not to twist, sl st in first ch to make ring.

Rnd1: ch2, hdc in next ch and in each ch around; sl st to top of ch2.

Rnd2: ch2,hdc in next st, fpdc in next st.*hdc in next 2sts,fpdc in next st; repeat from * around.

Rnd 3: ch 2, hdc or fpdc in like sts in Rnd 2.

Rnd 4: ch 2, hdc in each st of Rnd 3. When completed, sl st in next st, ch1. Begin to work in spiral rather than individual rows.

Rnds 5-20: sc in each st around. sl st in final st, ch 2.

Rnd 21: hdc in each st aroundsl st to top of ch 2.

Rnd 22: ch 2 then repeat Rnd 2 -2hdcs between fpdcs, sl st in ch 2. Rnd 23: ch 2, hdc in hdc and fpdc in fpdc of Rnd 22

Rnd 24: ch 2, hdc in each stitch of Rnd 23, sl st in ch 2.

Rnd 25: ch 1, sc in each hdc of Rnd 23, sl st to ch 1.

Finish off and weave in all ends.

Abbreviations:

ch = chain

st = stitch

yo = yarn over

sc = single crochet

sl st = slip stitch

hdc = half double crochet

fpdc = front post double crochet (YO, insert hook, from front to back, under stitch below, yo, take off 2 sts, yo, take off last 2 sts)
