Open to students in Jefferson County

Entry Requirements



Subject Matter

Art work should highlight one or more pollinator species (i.e. hummingbirds, bats, bees, beetles, butterflies, and flies) that carry pollen from one plant to another. For info about pollinators: <http://www.fws.gov/pollinators/Index.html>

Judging

The art will be judged on the basis of

- Concept: How well the work relates to the pollinator theme.
- Composition: How well the elements of line and form work together.
- Color: How color enhances the art work.
- Expression: How imaginatively the work conveys an idea or emotion.
- Originality: New portrayal of subject.
- Accuracy: Obvious artist did research on pollinators.

First, second, and third place winners will be selected and great prizes will be awarded. We will also have a People's Choice Award. Entries will be judged and winners notified prior to the CSU Extension Pollinator Celebration on June 24, 2017. All art entries will be displayed at the Jeffco Extension Horticulture Garden, 15200 West 6th Avenue Unit C, Golden, CO 80401.

***Master Gardeners will pick up the art work from the schools. Teachers can request date and time.**

Entry Requirements

- The art work can be portrait or landscape and any size but not larger than 18" x 24".
- Image must be a portrayal of one or more of the native pollinator species in its natural state.
- Artistic liberties may be taken as long as the depiction is a recognizable pollinator species.
- The entry may be any of these media: painting, drawing, mixed media, printmaking, photography, collage or fabric. 3-D art is accepted if a pedestal or something to display it on is provided.
- Art work that is 2-D must be matted or framed with a hanging device on the back so the art is ready to hang.
- Art must be wrapped or have a protective cover.
- Design entries must be entrant's original artwork and may not be traced or copied from published photographs or other artists' works. Entries as such will be disqualified.
- One entry per student is accepted.
- Completed entry form must be affixed to the back of the artwork.
- Conservation Message about the importance of conserving pollinator species must be included with art entry. See entry form.
- Entry deadline is May 5th, 2017.
- Judging will be done prior to June 24, 2017 and winners will be notified at that time.
