Paul demonstrates a sense of urgency in verse 2? Why is the Gospel urgent? Why shouldn't we delay in getting the news out?

What are some obstacles we could put in the way of people knowing Christ? (v. 3)

Paul continues to defend himself as an apostle in chapter 6. What does he point to in this passage as proof of his calling? (v. 3-10)

In verse 10, what does Paul mean when he says that he has become poor to make many rich?

How can Paul's example help us become more effective ambassadors for Christ?

How can you personally begin to be more intentional in . . .

encouraging other believers?
