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PROPOSED LANGUAGE AND CONTENT FOR THE INITIATIVE

The City Attorney for the City of Glendale has prepared the following circulating title and summary of the chief purpose and points of the proposed measure:

[Title and Summary]

Stop the Utility Users' Tax ("UUT")

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF Glendale DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Findings and Declarations

WHEREAS, the people of the City of Glendale find and declare that federal, state and local taxation has reached confiscatory levels; that unrestrained spending and regulation at all levels of government, are excessive, improvident, contrary to our rights as a free people and are thereby destructive of Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness.

Section 2. Name of Measure and Effective Date.

This measure shall be known as the Stop the Utility Users' Tax and shall become effective as provided by law.

Section 3. The existing Utility Users Tax as set forth in Chapter 4.36 of the Glendale Municipal Code is repealed in its entirety.

Section 4. Severability

The provisions of this initiative are severable. If any provision of this measure or application thereof is held invalid, that invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications if they can be given effect without the invalid provision or application.

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ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF CIRCULATORS

We, William Tallaferro, Kenneth Landon and John Voors, acknowledge that it is a misdemeanor under state law to knowingly or willfully allow the signatures on an initiative petition to be used for any purpose other than qualification of the proposed measure for the ballot.

We certify that we will not knowingly or willfully allow the signatures for this initiative to be used for any purpose other than qualification of the measure for the ballot.




