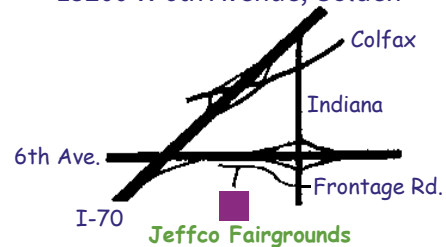

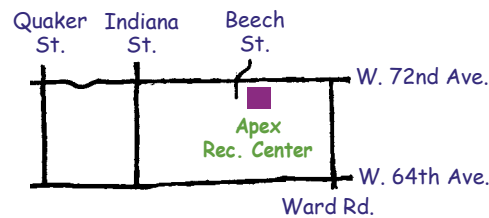
#### Central Site

### CAMP HOURS

**Drop-off 7:30 – 8 a.m.**

Jeffco school buses transport campers from base camp to and from sites, **leaving at 8 a.m. and returning at 4 p.m.** (barring unforeseen circumstances, traffic jams, etc.) **Parents are responsible for transportation to and from base camp.**

### ENOR's Distinctive Camp Culture

**Distinct from other outdoor camps are**

**ENOR's FOCUS, OUTDOOR ACTIVITY, CARE, and PARTNERSHIPS.**

**ENOR's FOCUS** is environmental education and youth development rather than recreation. Each day the curriculum highlights unique environmental and social themes that guide learning. Science, math, history, drama, art, and teamwork are woven into the activities to meet the diverse interests of the young learners.



**OUTDOOR ACTIVITY:** To encourage healthy lifestyles, active engagement with the outdoors, and perseverance through challenge, the camp day includes *hiking* in local parks and open spaces. Campers visit a unique location each day. (Third grade camp program is split between field trips and activities conducted at the Jeffco Fairgrounds.)



**CARE:** Campers are assigned to one caring educator for the week. This gives campers the opportunity to bond with their leader and peers, creating a pathway to comfort and safety, supporting an environment of learning. Camp staff is made up of trained professionals, many are licensed teachers, and all are First Aid/CPR certified.



*We do not accommodate requests for campers to be grouped with friends. However, we value that your child is interested in sharing his/her ENOR camp experience with a friend. Therefore the camp day is a balance of small and large group settings that allow all campers to spend time with familiar AND new friends!*



**PARTNERSHIPS:** Personalized instruction is paired with supplemental programming from a number of community partners that enhance the opportunity for the campers to broaden their horizons and interact with professionals in various fields.

## WOODPECKER'S HOLLOW – CRITTER CAMP!

**(For children entering 3rd grade in fall 2017)**

Woodpecker's Hollow is held at the Jefferson County Fairgrounds with field trips to Lair o' the Bear, Mt. Falcon Park, Lookout Mountain Nature Center, and a walking farm tour

**Sampling of activities:** Grab a net and go on an insect hunt; spend the day discovering the tiniest of critters; take a field trip to the Lookout Mtn. Nature Center to look for Wild Messages; meet real birds of prey and watch them fly overhead; see real chicks hatch; search for frogs, snakes, and other wildlife in a riparian habitat! The week is divided between activities at the fairgrounds and field trips.

## OWL'S ROOST (For children entering 4th grade in fall 2017)



Sites visited throughout the week: South Platte Park, Chatfield Reservoir, White Ranch, Elk Meadow, Alderfer Three Sisters

**Sampling of activities:** Visit the Chatfield Visitor Center and build a mini-dam; explore a turtle pond; sharpen outdoor survival skills & learn ten items that keep you safe; treasure hunt for animal and insect homes; find out how the sun makes energy for every living thing; explore forests observing the changing environment; participate in wildfire program with Jeffco Open Space Rangers!

## EAGLE'S NEST

**(For children entering 5th grade in fall 2017)**

Sites visited throughout the week: Reynolds Park, Golden Gate State Park, Central City, Nevadaville & Bald Mountain Cemetery, Red Rocks Park, Edgar Mine, and Saint Mary's Glacier



**Sampling of activities:** Learn how to identify trees by smelling and touching them; play wildlife games - will you be the predator or prey? Find out what it was like to live in a mining town, and learn to pan for gold; discover the wonders of geology; go on an exciting mine tour; learn about glaciers, and safely slide down one!

## FALCON'S AERIE

**(For children entering the 6th grade in the fall of 2017)**

Sites visited throughout the week: Deer Creek Canyon, Pine Valley Ranch, Bear Creek Water Shed, Flying J Ranch.



Treasure hunt in the woods to unlock the clues to \_\_\_\_\_? Hunt for insects, analyze their adaptations and take the adaptation team challenge; travel down Bear Creek, collect samples of the critters in the creek and maybe even get wet; practice forest management techniques with the Open Space Stewardship Team; build a highway fit for a matchbox car; get creative and paint the lovely scenery; teams create and film an ad about sustainability!
