Verses for the Week

Rev. 22:9b “Worship God”

Rev. 14:7 Saying with a loud voice, Fear God and give Him glory...and worship Him who has made heaven and earth and the sea and the springs of waters.

Matt. 4:9-10 And [the devil] said to Him, All these will I give You if You will fall down and worship me. Then Jesus said to him, Go away, Satan! For it is written, “You shall worship the Lord your God, and Him only shall you serve.”

Heb. 11:4 By faith Abel offered to God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, through which he obtained the testimony that he was righteous, God testifying to his gifts; and through faith, though he has died, he still speaks.

Exo. 20:24 An altar of earth you shall make for Me, and you shall sacrifice on it your burnt offerings and your peace offerings, your sheep and your oxen...

John 4:14 But whoever drinks of the water that I will give him shall by no means thirst forever; but the water that I will give him will become in him a fountain of water springing up into eternal life.

John 4:24 God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truthfulness.

Excerpts from the Ministry

The last commandment in the New Testament is to worship God.

Whereas Abel worshipped God according to divine revelation, Cain worshipped according to his own opinion and concept.

Exodus 20:22-26 reveals the statutes of the law concerning the worship of God.

While Moses was receiving the divine revelation concerning the worship of God, Aaron made a golden calf, and the children of Israel worshipped it as if it were the true God.

To see God is to worship Him, as revealed in Exodus 24:1, 10-11.

The divine dispensing of the Divine Trinity is the supply to the believers in their worship of the Father in the dispensing of God.
