Saskatchewan's Apprenticeship and Trade Certification Program Celebrated 60 Years of Industry-Led Training and Certification

April 1, 2004 was the 60th anniversary date of the apprenticeship and trade certification program in Saskatchewan. The Commission took the opportunity throughout the year to promote 60 years of skill development in the trades to all its stakeholder audiences and the public.

Apprenticeship Award Celebration November 5, 2004

The Saskatchewan Apprenticeship and Trade Certification Commission's annual apprenticeship awards event celebrates certification in the trades - journey person certification earned through apprenticeship training or through the tradesperson route.

The awards are presented for outstanding achievement in

training and certification, for the apprenticeship year July 1, 2003 to June 30, 2004, and honour the partnerships that are required to achieve skilled and certified workers in the trades.

- 49 outstanding new journey persons were honoured.

- **SIASST Kelsey Campus Partsperson** program received honourable mention for adapting on-line and distance delivery to Level one apprentices, when insufficient numbers of apprentices were available to attend a block delivery course.

- Employers and supervising journey persons were recognized for their mentorship of the award recipients.

- **SED Systems Electronics Assembler Training Program received the Outstanding Technical Training Team Award.** Training delivery for electronics assembler apprentices was reorganized into smaller delivery components, so that lengthy training wouldn't affect industry's ability to meet its monthly production and shipping deadlines.

- **The Welder Trade Board received the Outstanding Trade Board Award** for their pro-active work in the trade. The board carried out a survey of the industry to determine Saskatchewan's needs for the welder trade. The board also revised the practical examination to meet Saskatchewan's unique industry needs; they were involved in revising the National Occupational Analysis; and they participated in the inter-provincial item banking workshops.

- **The Cosmetologist Trade Board** received honourable mention for the extensive work they have done in revising their practical examination.
