Verses for the Week

Exo. 24:8 So Moses took the blood and sprinkled it on the people and said, Here is the blood of the covenant, which Jehovah has made with you in accordance with all these words.

Luke 22:20 And similarly the cup after they had dined, saying, This cup is the new covenant established in My blood, which is being poured out for you.

Exo. 24:4 And Moses wrote down all the words of Jehovah. And he...built an altar at the base of the mountain and twelve pillars for the twelve tribes of Israel.

Matt. 26:28 For this is My blood of the covenant, which is being poured out for many for forgiveness of sins.

Rev. 22:14 Blessed are those who wash their robes that they may have right to the tree of life and may enter by the gates into the city.

Rev. 7:14 ...And he said to me, These are those who come out of the great tribulation, and they have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

Excerpts from the Ministry

The precious blood of Christ satisfies God, it is the believers' access to God, and it overcomes all the accusations of the enemy; we need to go further to see that the Lord's precious blood is the blood of the covenant.

We need to see God's intention in decreeing the law.

We need to see the relationship between the redeeming blood and the presence of God.

Moses was a man who knew God's heart and His intention; therefore, he enacted the law not according to the intention of the children of Israel but according to the intention of God.

The blood of the covenant is primarily for God to be our portion for our enjoyment.

Eventually, the blood of Christ as the blood of the new covenant ushers God's people into the better things of the new covenant, in which God gives His people a new heart, a new spirit, His Spirit, the inner law of life (denoting God Himself with His nature, life, attributes, and virtues), and the ability of life to know God.

Ultimately, the blood of the new covenant, the eternal covenant, enables God's people to serve Him and leads God's people into the full enjoyment of God as their portion (as the tree of life and the water of life) both now and for eternity.
