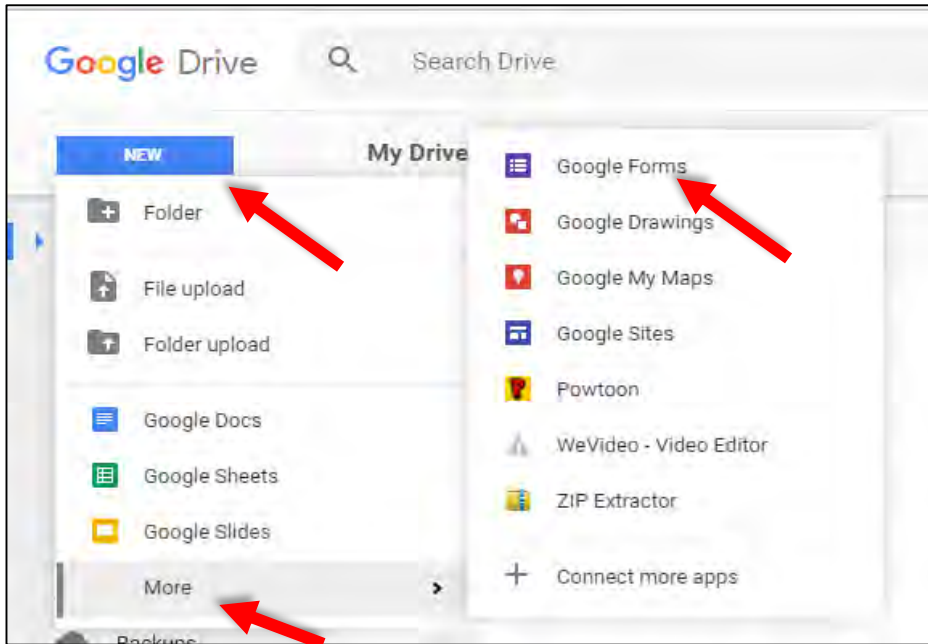


How to Create a Self-Grading Quiz In **GOOGLE** forms

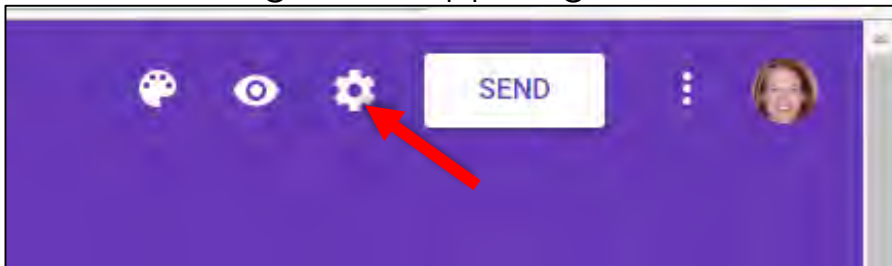
Use Google Forms for formative and summative assessment and for fun class challenges. Create:

1. Tests
2. Quizzes
3. Exit Quizzes
4. Games and more!

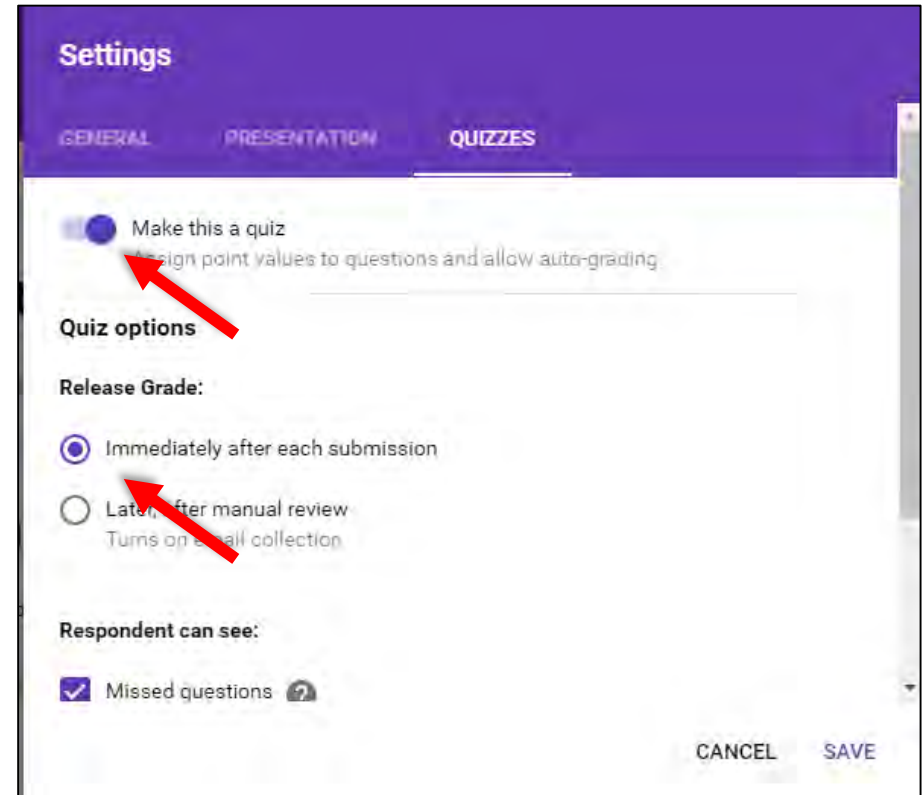
1. Go to your DRIVE, and open a new form.



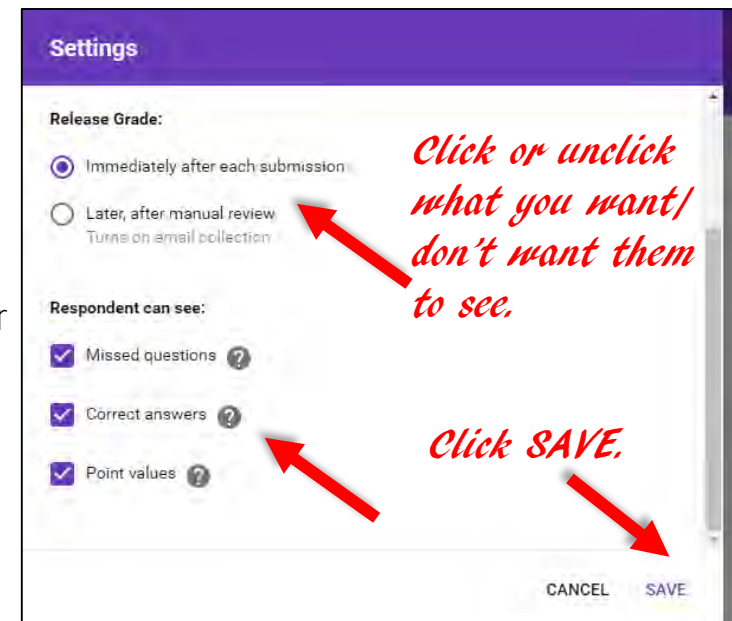
2. Go to "settings in the upper right corner.



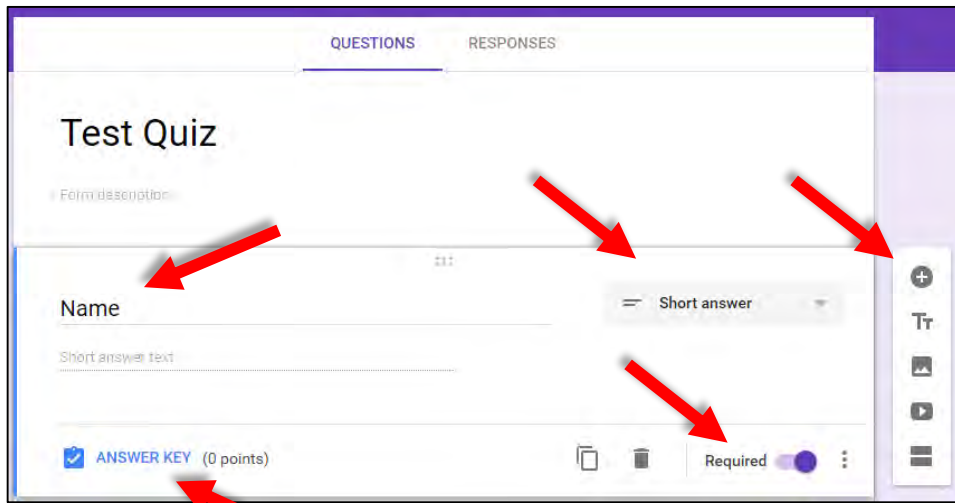
3. In settings, select quizzes and then "make this a quiz." I like to select that students can see their grade immediately.



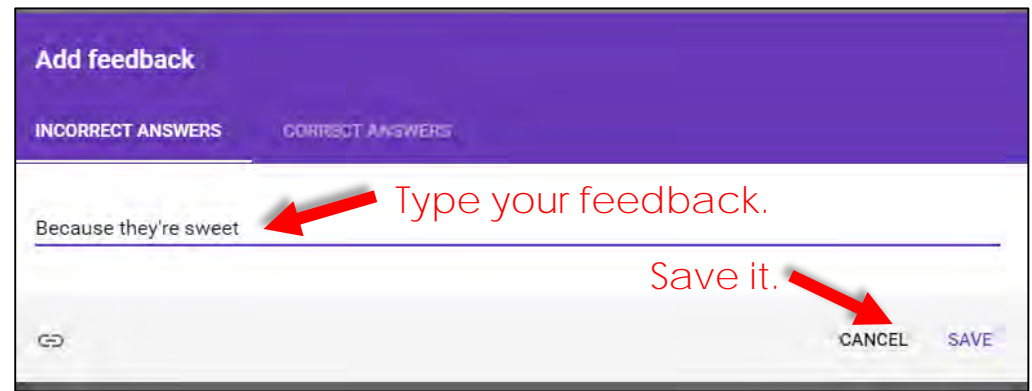
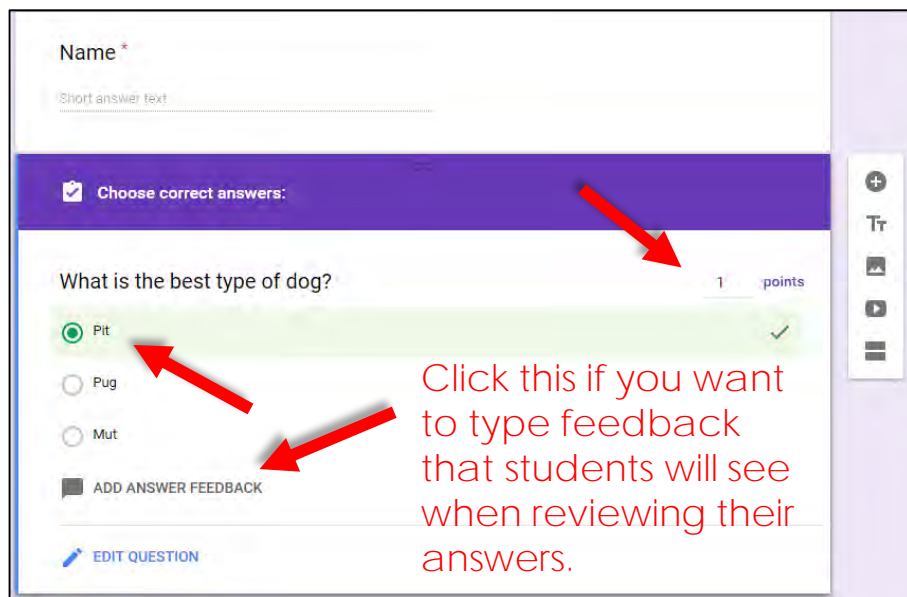
4. You have the option to choose whether or not students can see their grades immediately, their missed questions and the correct answers to them, and the point value.



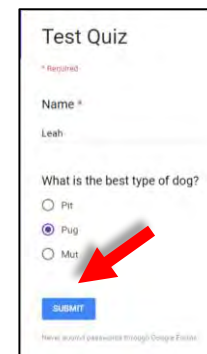
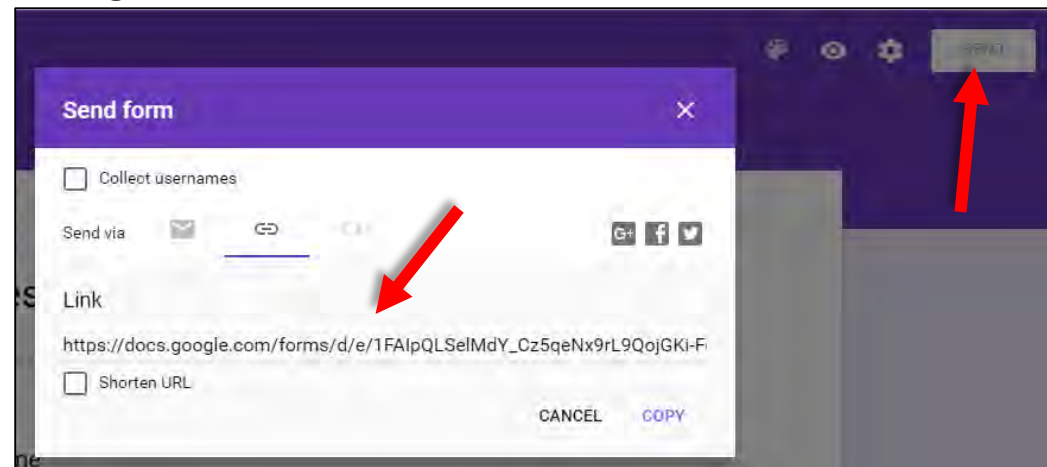
5. Make your first question (their name) mandatory and short answer.



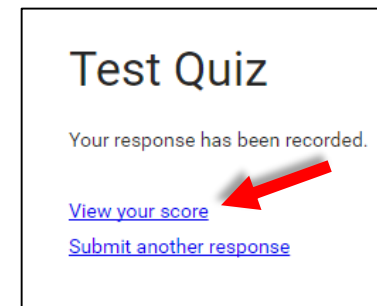
6. Type your questions. For each new question, select the + sign on the right. Make it multiple choice by clicking on the drop box on the right. For all of the other questions, in order to make the quiz self-grading, you will need to select "Answer Key." Give it a point value, and click on the correct answer.



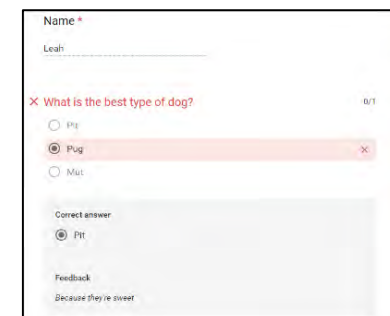
7. When you finish typing the quiz, select "send" in the upper right hand corner. Copy the link, and either email it to your students or share it in Google Classroom.



Students will see this view. When they finish, they will hit "submit."



After submitting, they should select "view your score."
