Number of U21 Places Offered

Up to five per calendar year, on a first come first served basis. Sixth and subsequent U21 medical elective students are welcome to apply on a fee paying space available basis.

Dates offered: 1 February to 30 November annually

Note: applications for December to January will not be considered

Length: 4 to 8 weeks

Application deadline: 31 March 2017 for any elective in 2018.

Disciplines/ Sub-specialty: Anaesthesia; ICU/DCCM; Specialty Medicine; Paediatrics; Radiology; Specialty Surgery.

Admission Requirements

- Genuine Medical student in final year of study, having completed at least two years of clinical study at the time of the elective from a U21 university participating in the student mobility programme.
- Be competent in Clinical English.
- English Language IELTS 7.5 with no band less than 7.0 if medical degree programme not taught in English.
- Proof of Immunity and MRSA declaration required.
- Certificate of Good Conduct / Police Check from Home country AND NZ Police Check required.
- Evidence of Malpractice Insurance and Travel and Health Insurance for the duration of elective required.
- *Note: students must comply with the Rules and Regulations of the Electives programme*

Required documents at the point of application: completed application form, recent photo, Dean's recommendation letter, a letter issued by the applicant's medical school certifying the completion of infection control training.

- Language: MOI English or proof of a high level of proficiency
- Must be in the their last two years of study in medical program
- Required documents at the point of application:
 - A Letter of Motivation from the student
 - The student's CV
 - The student's academic transcript (in English)
 - English Language Certificate (to certify the level of English the student has)
 - A passport size photo of the student
 - A photocopy of the student's personal details in their passport
 - Proof of Hepatitis B Immunity (Serology Report) and Hepatitis A immunisation
 - [Blue Card application and Identification forms](#) if the student is applying for paediatrics
- Documents required once accepting the placement
 - Criminal History Check
 - Public liability insurance for not less than AUD\$20 million per occurrence (please contact us if you have trouble with this)
 - Professional indemnity insurance valued at AUD\$10 million per occurrence
 - Proof that they have applied for a Tourist Visa (subclass 676) (International Students)
