

## Beer

### 1. Odell Brewing, Cutthroat Porter 7

American Porter / Colorado / 5.1% ABV / Pint

A true porter is smooth and robust. Inspired by the classic London porters, with roasted malts to create a deep, rich color and flavor.

### 2. Real Ale, Gose 7

Gose/ Blanco, Texas / 4.4% ABV / Pint

A slightly sour wheat beer, it's known for hints of coriander and a unique saltiness that is derived from the local water source, with fresh lime juice.

### 3. Buffalo Bayou, Summer's Wit 7

Witbier / Texas / 6% ABV / Pint

Look for a big floral nose, light citrus flavors in the mouthfeel and a bone dry coriander on the finish.

### 4. Karbach, Staycation 7

American Pale Wheat Ale / Houston / 4.8% ABV / Pint

Make the most of your Staycation with this fantastic Texas Session Beer brewed with bright, citrusy aromatic hops and a touch of wheat for a smooth finish.

### 5. Brash Brewery, EZ 7 7

American Pale Ale / Houston / 5% ABV / Pint

This beer is named after a legendary Houston skate park. An American Pale with absurd levels of dry hopping, and featuring aromas of apricot, gauva and resinous pine.

### 6. Lone Pint, Yellow Rose 8

American IPA / Magnolia / 6.8% ABV / Pint

Dry, hoppy a little pine and a little passion fruit in the mouth - a perfect Texas IPA for every Texas day.

### 7. Austin EastCiders, Dry Cider 8

Cider / Austin, Texas / 5% ABV / Pint

Two types of apples leave this slightly dry cider with a subtle complexity

### 8. Ballast Point, Grunion 7

Pale Ale / California / 5.5% ABV / Pint

A pair of new hop varieties lend strong yet balanced summer melon aromas and herbal flavors, while a soft caramell malt sweetness holds it all together.

### 9. Brooklyn, Chocolate Stout 8

Russian Imperial Chocolate Stout / New York / 10% ABV / Snifter

Brewed with six malts and enough hops to survive a sea voyage to Russia this stout is aged six months to obtain a perfect chocolate balance.

### 10. Hops and Grain, The One They Call Zoe 7

American Pale Lager / Texas / 5.2% ABV / Pint

With notes of lightly toasted bread, floral hops and an incredibly smooth finish this beer is the One.

### 11. Sierra Nevada, Hoptimum 8

Imperial IPA / California / 10.4 % ABV / Tulip

Aggressively hopped, dry-hopped and torpedoed with exclusive new hop varieties for ultra-intense flavors and aroma, citrus and floral notes.

### 12. Down House Ginger Beer 4

House Recipe, Non-Alcoholic

We make this in-house and force carbonate it in kegs. It is really good.
