Horse Demonstration - competitive team (2 member groups) or individual contest

Talent – individual or group contest



Fashion Revue – individual contest held before County Fair

COUNTY & STATE TEAMS

Participation of an adult coach is required for these county teams to occur.

Consumer Choices – competitive team (4 member groups) or individual activity

Horse Judging - competitive team (3 - 4 member groups) activity.

Horse Bowl – competitive team (4 member groups) activity

Hippology – competitive team (4 member groups) activity

Livestock Bowl - competitive team (4 member + 1 alternate groups)

Livestock Judging - competitive team (3 - 4 member groups) or individual activity

Performance Horse Team - competitive team of Level III & Level IV riders

Rabbit Judging - competitive team (4 member groups) or individual activity
