CERVANTES

Miguel de Cervantes Saavedra (September 9, 1547 - April 23, 1616), (Ejemplo) _____ a Spanish author, best known (1) _____ his novel Don Quixote de la Mancha.

Cervantes was (2) _____ to a family of modest means in 1547 in Alcalá de Henares, Spain. He never obtained a university education. In 1569 he left for Italy where some elegies he (3) _____ were published. He also joined a Spanish regiment there and was wounded while fighting in the Battle of Lepanto against the Turks in 1571; (4) _____ a consequence, he lost the use of left (5) _____. From then on he was (6) _____ 'el manco de Lepanto' (Lepanto's one-handed). In 1575, while returning to Spain from (7) _____ Netherlands, he was captured by Barbary pirates based in Algiers and held captive there until he (8) _____ liberated in 1580.

Cervantes began writing Don Quixote (9) _____ 1597 while imprisoned in Seville for debt. In 1605 he published Part I of his major work, (10) _____ known as El Ingenioso Hidalgo Don Quijote de la Mancha (The Ingenious Gentleman Don Quixote of La Mancha). Part II did not appear until 1615.
