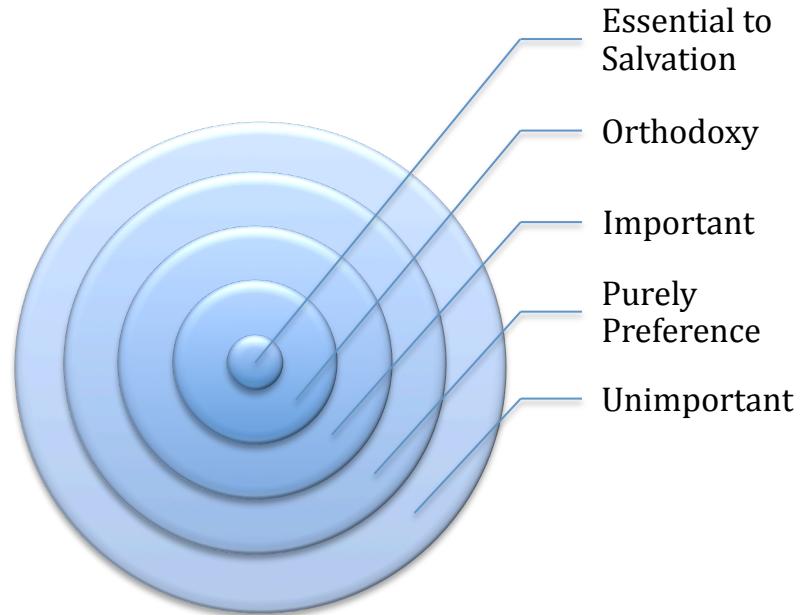


# Understanding Levels of Importance

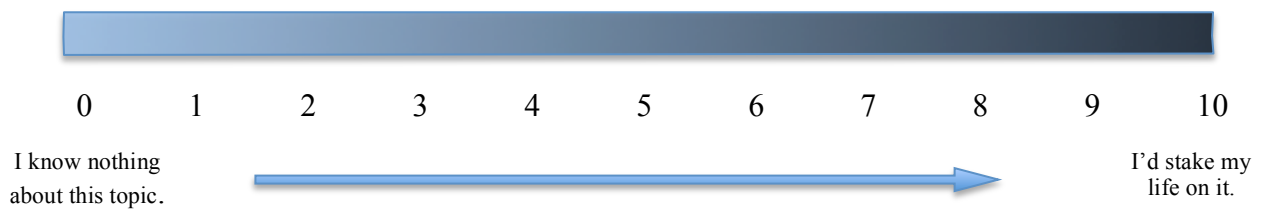
*“For Christianity, beliefs matter, but not all beliefs matter equally.”<sup>1</sup>*
