

2 Corinthians 10 Study Questions

Read 2 Corinthians 10

What accusations was Paul defending himself against?

What is the difference between walking in the flesh and walking according to the flesh? (v. 2)

Verse 4 mentions weapons of warfare. Paul describes a list of these weapons in his letter to the Ephesians. Read **Ephesians 6:10-18**. What are the different parts of the armor of God and what are their functions?

Verse 5 contains fantastic rhetoric, but how do we practically “take captive every thought and make it obedient to Christ”?

Who does Paul belong to? (**2 Corinthians 10:6**) What’s the point he is trying to make?

Read **2 Corinthians 5:16**. How does it apply to this passage and the problems people were causing in the Corinthian church?

What was one of the consequences of the dissension in the church? (**2 Corinthians 10:16**)

When we take our eyes off of Christ, why does it seem like evangelism and outreach are the first things to go?

Read and Memorize 2 Corinthians 10:17. What does it mean to boast in the Lord?

Whose opinion of you is the one that matters?

Here are verses we read in church this past Sunday. I recommend reading and meditating on one verse each day this week.

Psalm 90:2

Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever you had formed the earth and the world, from everlasting to everlasting you are God.

Hebrews 1:10-12

And, "You, Lord, laid the foundation of the earth in the beginning, and the heavens are the work of your hands; they will perish, but you remain; they will all wear out like a garment, like a robe you will roll them up, like a garment they will be changed. But you are the same, and your years will have no end."

Psalm 34:8

Oh, taste and see that the Lord is good! Blessed is the man who takes refuge in him!

Lamentations 3:22-23

The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases; his mercies never come to an end 23 they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.

But you, O Lord, are a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness.

Ephesians 2:4-5

But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us, 5 even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved.

1 Samuel 2:2

"There is none holy like the Lord: for there is none besides you; there is no rock like our God."

Isaiah 44:6
