## **Boulder County Fair Jr. Livestock Sale Committee Scholarship**

### Scholarship requirements:

1. Have to have sold a project in the Boulder County Fair Jr. Market sale for three years.
2. Must be a high school senior, or a full time student at a credible junior/community college or university.
3. Must have a minimum GPA of 2.5.
4. Must complete scholarship application and return it to the Boulder County Extension Office by May 1.

Scholarships will be awarded during the Jr. Livestock Sale during fair.

5. Must provide the most recent high school or college transcript
6. Interview may be requested.
7. There will be a maximum of six scholarships awarded and a minimum of one scholarship with no more than \$2000.00 awarded total per year.
8. Scholarships will be mailed directly to college / university.
9. Scholarship must be used within one year of receiving the award.
