

2017 – 2018 4-H Member Fee Schedule Deadlines and Eligibility Requirements

Important! The Re-enrollment deadline is December 22, 2017 It is our goal to have all returning members re-enrolled and supplied with all project materials in a timely manner. We will continue to accept new enrollments throughout the year. The 4-H office is available for any club needing enrollment assistance.

FEE SCHEDULE

- \$45** Early-bird enrollment fee for new or returning 4-H members October 1 – December 22, 2017
Record books are included in the enrollment fee; members pay for all project books.
- \$90** *Re-enrolling members* – December 22, 2017, through the end of the 4-H year. Record books are included in the enrollment fee; members pay for all project books.
- \$45** *New member enrollment* - Record books are included in the enrollment fee; members pay for all project books. (A new member is defined as anyone who has never been enrolled or has not been enrolled within the last two 4-H enrollment years in Jefferson County 4-H program.)

ENROLLMENT DEADLINE FOR COUNTY/STATE FAIR COMPETITION – MAY 1, 2018

(Beef project members must be enrolled by February 11, 2018)

All 4-H members and leaders must be enrolled for the current program year to participate in county and out-of-county 4-H sponsored events and activities held previous to May 1. Members and leaders must re-enroll each program year.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

4-H Members

Members are between the ages of 8 and 18 (as of 12/31/17)

Junior Members are ages 8 to 10

Intermediate Members are ages of 11 to 14

Senior Members are ages of 14 to 18

Cloverbuds are between the ages of 5 to 7 (as of 12/31/17)

Cloverbuds are non-competitive

Cloverbuds DO NOT work with live animals or shooting sports

Members do not need to reside in Jefferson County to enroll in Jeffco 4-H; however, members must submit enrollments to one county only. Agent approval is required for out-of-county enrollments.

4-H Leaders

Must be at least 19 years of age (as of 12/31/17)

Must complete a volunteer leader application and background check before working with members

Must complete orientation before approval of leadership

To chaperone an event, adults must be at least 21 years of age and be an enrolled 4-H leader
