

Sticky Faith Sunday
2 Chronicles 34

Bible Story: Josiah: The boy who became king (2 Chronicles 34). In 2 Chronicles 34 we meet Josiah who at the age of 8 becomes king of Judah. The immense task of ruling over God's people would have been difficult for anyone, but God used Josiah to bring His people back to worshipping Him.

Instructions: Once again we are emphasizing the importance of investing in the next generation. Instead of providing a community group discussion guide we are providing a discussion for members to have with those kids/grandkids who may attend the service with them. It is just another way we are prioritizing the value we are placing on investing in the next generation of spiritual heroes!

Questions to discuss as follow up to the message:

- Josiah was given an extremely important position and job as king of Judah. Let each member of your family tell about a big job or task that you have been given to do at some point in your life. What made it so challenging? What did you do to be able to complete the job? How did it go?
- At a very young age Josiah was God's instrument to bring the people of Judah back to God. What were some of the ways that Josiah showed his love for the Lord? What are ways that we show our love for God?
- Josiah was unable to accomplish all of the reforms on his own. He had help! How did others help him accomplish what God wanted from Him? Isn't it great to know that God puts other people in our life to help us do what He wants us to! Who are some people in your life who help you love God and be obedient to Him? How do they do so?
