Description of position:	Lifeguards are responsible for guarding swimmers and for the safe and efficient operations in Wildwater Kingdom. This includes enforcing rules, giving information and answering questions, watching the pools and waterslide to make sure that all guests are safe, performing life-saving techniques when needed as described and practiced in lifeguard certification training. This is a great job if you like to swim, or if you like to be outdoors, or if you want to gain skills on how to work as part of a large team. Our lifeguards win awards as a team every summer, so this is a job where team work is important.
Specific qualifications required:	<p>Must pass drug test. No prior lifeguarding experience necessary. Must attend and complete training sessions and pass lifeguard training that is done once you arrive. Lifeguard training classes are provided by Dorney Park. Must attend monthly in service trainings. Must be able to work outdoors in all types of weather (this is a job where you will be in the sun at all times) for entire work shift and enjoy being in/around the water. For safety purposes, the ability to speak and understand English must be excellent. ## Other Job Details

Minimum english level: (6) Advanced

Description of working conditions: Jobs will be outdoors, in the sun with limited shaded areas. Temperatures in Pennsylvania can be very hot and humid in the summer. Students will need to be able to stand for an entire shift. Students will be required to scan the pool and aquatics areas continuously as trained. Other duties include maintaining cleanliness of location. Students must not have allergies to cleaning chemicals or direct sunlight.

Will job duties be different at the beginning of the season? No

If yes, provide details of specific job duties: During the summer (May-September 7) the employer guarantees at least 30 hours per week. Typically, in July and August the park is busier and it may be possible to work extra hours, but this depends on weather, crowd size and staffing. After Labor Day (September 5) park is open on WEEKENDS ONLY. After Labor Day, students will work on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays, but there may be some work during the weekdays setting up Haunt and doing cleaning and inventory. Students are encouraged to travel during their time off to nearby east coast cities on weekdays in September when travel is cheaper and attractions less crowded. After Labor Day WaterPark closes and then Lifeguards are moved into Ride Attendants positions.

Details of purchasing required clothing or footwear: Employees will receive uniform from the Park Wardrobe Department. Employees will need to provide their own white or black athletic shoes and socks (Lifeguards - water sandal with a heel strap). Shoes must have a slip resistant sole. Uniform must be returned at the end of their job.

Optional items are also available for purchase including belts, sweatshirts and fleece, rain suits, sunglasses and warm-up suits.

LIFEGUARDS: Special uniform requirements - The lifeguard position requires athletic sandals. The sandals must be waterproof and have a strap over the top of the foot and around the heel. Sandals that only have straps between the toes (flip-flops) are prohibited.

Drug testing is done for those in safety sensitive positions (Lifeguards & Ride Operators) prior to beginning work. Will do random drug testing of all associates throughout season. Others may be tested for cause and questionable activity. Completion of job certifications are issued upon request of employees at the end of their employment. We expect employees to work the dates to which they agree at the job fair and make few exceptions. Dorney Park is owned & operated by Cedar Fair entertainment company. We operate several amusement parks in the United States, including Cedar Point, Valley Fair, Worlds Of Fun, Kings Dominion and Carowinds. These parks also have work and travel programs.

Housing details:	<p>Dorney Park partners with a local college. Students are housed in the college dormitory. Students will share rooms (2-3 employees per room). Girls' dormitory available May 15-September 30. Boys can only live in dorm from May 15-August 12 (we will arrange hotel housing for boys for early spring and fall through September at same cost). Couples will need to either find own housing or must split up (girls in girls dorm/boys in boys dorm)</p> <p>Housing in the dormitories costs up to \$70 per week. Weekly housing cost is based on number of hours worked. Employees pay \$1.40/hour worked for housing. This is capped at 50 hours (or \$70 total). Therefore, if a student works more than 50 hours in one week, housing still costs \$70. However, if a student works 30 hours in one week, housing will cost \$42.00.</p> <p>Employees who wish to find their own housing can apply for a housing subsidy - \$40 per week if paying more than \$165/month in rent and working 35.0 hours or more per week. Those living in dorms do not qualify for housing subsidy.</p> <p>Amenities in dormitory: Air Conditioning, free WIFI in each room, communal kitchen and bathrooms in each dorm, use of some of additional college facilities (snack bar, library, bookstore, can purchase swim pass for indoor pool, gym pass.).
