Read 2 Corinthians 3:7-18

Background Text: Exodus 33 and 34

How does Paul compare and contrast the Old Covenant and the New Covenant?

Why has the New Covenant surpassed the Old Covenant?

Why is it impossible to be saved through the law?

Read Philippians 3:7-9. How does it say we are made righteous?

What does it mean to “place your faith in Christ”?

2 Corinthians 3:12 says, “Since we have such a hope, we are very bold.” To what hope is Paul referring?

How does hope make us bold to live out our faith and ultimately share it with others?

Romans 10:1 says, “Brothers, my heart's desire and prayer to God for them is that they may be saved.” Write down at least 3 people who you can begin praying for their salvation and an opportunity to share.

We looked at two foundational Christian doctrines this week. What does justification mean?

Sanctification?

Compare and contrast the two.
