Description about your club. What do you guys do each meeting? (What would you tell someone who's interested in joining?) Activities revolve around the specific projects. The horse group meets monthly to learn about horse care. In addition, throughout the school year, the group rides twice a month. In the summer rides are weekly with many members participating in weekend horse shows. The dog group meets monthly. These meetings involve dog training as well as dog care. Vet Science meets monthly. Activities may involve cow heart dissection, visits to local vets, etc. Leathercraft meets at least monthly. Participants work on individual projects that are then submitted as entries at the county fair. Livestock has involved members raising and caring for lambs (both for market and wool), swine, and poultry. Heritage arts is a new project and includes beginning sewing, knitting, and spinning.
