## **Title: Elijah part 2: Standing before the LORD.**

### **Overview**

Elijah was able to say what he said to Ahab because he stood before the LORD. He was not dazzled by earthly pomp and power because he had seen the brightness of God's glory. He knew God's word (Deuteronomy 11:13–17) which was a firm foundation for his prayers. He was God's servant and therefore had more authority than any earthly king.

Standing before the LORD is a place of:

- Glory and worship
- Promise and prayer
- Approval and authority
