ISOLATION/QUARANTINE



- Not an issue, a continuum of issues
- Three dimensions
 - Impairment
 - Duration
 - Level

IMPAIRMENT

- High levels of impairment lead to lower interaction with other dimensions
- High levels of impairment become labor intensive
- High levels of impairment drive logistics demand



DURATION

- Dictates needs for infrastructure
- Dictates needs for logistics
- Impacts functional needs to be addressed
- Impacts the demand for “sin”



QUARANTINE LEVEL

- Ranges from hospital isolation to “shelter-in-place”
- Indicates the relative deprivation people will undergo
- Higher level of quarantine increases demand for “sin”
- Interacts with both duration and client impairment



ISSUES TO CONSIDER

- Think Maslow
- Logistics
 - Food/water/hygiene
 - Personal items (sanitary items, grooming goods)
 - Medications – prescription and OTC
 - Entertainment
- Guidance – not much
 - ARC
 - Preserving normalcy



ISSUES TO CONSIDER

- “Sin”
 - Demand is there, but hard to meet
 - Will escalate in presence of unmet needs
- Functional needs
- Emergent demands
