1. **First...** Skim, scan, and preview the text!
2. **Next...** Look at ALL the non-fiction text features!
3. **Finally...** Ask yourself the following questions:
 - What is the author's purpose in writing this text? (**P.I.E.** = Is it **P**ersuasive, **I**nformational, or **E**ntertaining?)
 - What is the subject/topic?
 - How is it organized?
 - How are the chapters divided?
 - What comes first? What comes after? What comes at the end?
 - Does it follow a timeline? Does it follow a logical sequence? Does it indicate a problem-resolution-solution? Is it a simple list of items? Is it a comparison of two objects? Is there a cause and effect relationship? Does it describe something with many details?
 - What sort of language and vocabulary do you see?
 - What kind of topic sentences do you see?
 - What signal words do you see?
 - What are the text features that will help you collect and understand the information?
