SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Scholarship Program is a means to allow more 4-H members to raise livestock animals. The program allows 4-H members to re-invest their scholarship money back into their livestock educational experience. Alternately, remaining funds will be set aside for scholarships for a participant's future needs, such as funding for college, trade school, or the start-up of a new business. The amount of the scholarship award is based on a point system, and it will vary depending upon which livestock animal is involved and levels of 4-H program participation including leadership and community service.
