

## Nanaimo LBC Visit 03 March, 2018

<b>Schedule</b>	<p>A one-day short mat mixed draw will be held Saturday 03 March, 2018 among Oak Bay and Nanaimo LBC players. We will be using three mats.</p> <p>All games take place in Anderson House and Carnarvon House, OBLBC.</p> <p>Bring your own lunch. Tea and coffee will be provided.</p>
<b>Entries</b>	<p>This will be a mix of players from Nanaimo Lawn Bowling Club and Oak Bay Bowling Club. There will be 12 players from Nanaimo and we are looking for 12-18 players from Oak Bay. This is NOT a tournament but a social occasion for players from both clubs to mix and have a fun time playing the short mat game.</p> <p>Oak Bay players enter individually, using the RSVP entry system from the <a href="#">website short mat calendar</a>.</p> <p>Players from Nanaimo will play three games. Players from Oak Bay will play two or three games depending on the number of entries.</p> <p>Realistically, 18 players from Oak Bay will be the maximum. Some position-sharing will be needed, with OBLBC numbers between 13-18.</p> <p>Players will be assigned to teams randomly by the organizers.</p> <p>Volunteers are welcome for: the kitchen; supplying baked goods; and setup/take down. Indicate your volunteering preference when you register for this event.</p>
<b>Enrollment period</b>	<p>Online registration for Oak Bay players is now open and will close when the maximum numbers are reached.</p> <p>The schedule for all games will be published by Thursday 01 March. Schedule and teams will be <b>E-Mailed</b>.</p>
<b>Format</b>	<p>The format is mixed teams (Oak Bay and Nanaimo) in a two-bowl, eight-end, triples format. We are allowing one hour per match, starting at 10 a.m.; then at hourly intervals, starting the last match at 2 p.m. There will be a lunch break 12 p.m. to 1 p.m. The bar will open around 2 p.m.</p>
<b>Standings</b>	<p>The only standings will be "a good time to be had by all."</p>
<b>Rules</b>	<p>The only rule is for everybody to have a good time, while recognizing the <a href="#">CSMBA rules</a> with <a href="#">local changes</a>.</p>
<b>Limitations</b>	<p>Eight or ten teams of triples.</p>
