
LANDING ZONE



Material

- Red paper for Girls
- Blue paper for Boys
- Hula Hoop

Possible Modification

If you have a bigger space you could use multiple hula hoops and assigned different values for each hula hoop. At the end of the game you add up the values of all the planes in landing zones.



How to Play

This is a boys verse girls games or you can divide your group up evenly. One group has blue paper and the other group have red paper.

Teams are given two minutes to makes as many airplanes as they can and throw them into the landing zone. The landing zone is either one or multiple hula hoops in the center of the room, depending on your group size. Make sure you students don't get to close to your landing zone you may want to create a boundary if this is not clear with your room set up. The winner of this game is the group that has the most planes inside of the landing zone at the end of the game.

Pro Tip:

Find a great bomber jacket and instead of using a normally timer crank up "Danger Zone" on your sound system and students have until the song is over to throw their last plane.
