
When you see the word

## READY

get ready to listen and read the problem. You can get your white board and marker ready. This is your signal to erase your board if needed. When you see the word

## SET

you can start working out the problem and showing your answer on your white board.



When you see the word SHOW

hold up your white board and show off your answer. Make sure your teacher can see it.
