#### **SYNOD ON THE FAMILY (OCTOBER 2014)**

Pope Francis has called for an Extraordinary Synod to take place in Rome 5-19 October 2014. Around 150 Synod Fathers including Archbishop Vincent Nichols will take part in the meeting to discuss the 'pastoral challenges of the family in the context of evangelisation' and how best to re-propose the centrality of matrimony and the transmission of faith in the home within the proclamation of the Gospel in contemporary society.
