Some terminology to keep in mind:

- Religion, as a generic term, will be used to refer to distinct religions, as well as sects, denominations, schools, cults, etc.
- Main Religion refers to whichever religion has the most followers, money, power, and/or public approval
- Major Religion refers to any religion that 20%, or more, of the population follows
- Brother Religion refers to a religion that is distinct, but still shares core beliefs of the main religion
- Common Religion refers to any religion that 5-20% of the population follows
- Minor Religion refers to any religion that 1-5% of the population follows
- Secret Religion refers to any religion that cannot be openly followed, for whatever reason
