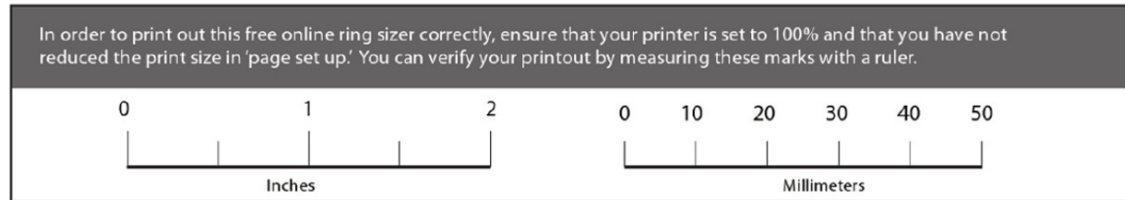

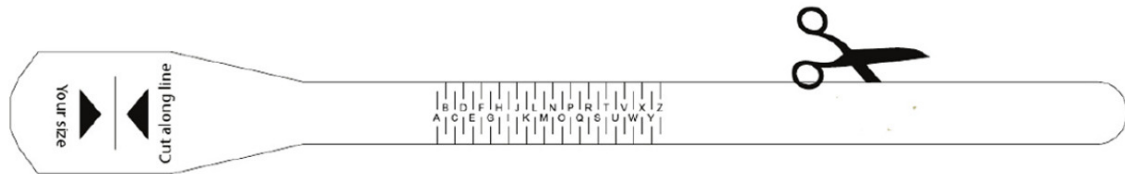
Printable ring sizer

If you are purchasing a ring for someone else, it is worth asking their relatives or friends if they know what size he/she is. Alternatively, below are two highly practical ways to find out what size ring you require.



Option A

- Cut around the sizer and make a slit where indicated
- Make a loose circle by slipping the end through the slit then place on the finger being measured and tighten
- To get an accurate gauge, please make sure hands are warm and preferably late in the day as cold fingers are slimmer and the ring will be sized too tight
- Alternatively forward your address to us and we will post out a plastic finger size gauge for you



Tip: back the ring sizer image with cellotape before cutting out

Option B

Using an existing ring that fits the finger you are sizing for, place it on the ring outlines below to determine the correct size. The right size will be when the edge of the circle touches the inside of your ring all the way around. If your ring sits between two sizes, please select the bigger size.
