Course Life Groups

C1 Alpha

Thursday @ 7.30pm (Mariners Hall)

Starts: 5 October (10 weeks)

Alpha is an opportunity to explore the meaning of life in an informal, fun and friendly environment. It is ideal for those who simply have questions about life or who want to know more about Christianity. Alpha runs in 169 countries and has been done by over 30 million people worldwide, including several million in the UK. It remains one of the most effective tools for evangelism in the world today. So, do think and pray about who you could invite along.

The course is 'no cost, no obligation' and consists of 10 evenings around a good meal together, a presentation (looking at topics including 'Who is Jesus?' and 'How can we have faith?') and then discussion in small groups. As the basis for each session, we are again using the excellent Alpha films released in 2016.

There is also a day away after eight weeks on Saturday 25 November in Churcham (about 15 mins out of Gloucester). More details will follow.

The course will be launched with a comedy night in Dr Fosters in the Docks on **Thursday 28 September** (tickets £10 per pair) featuring funny man Mark Palmer. This is a fantastic event to invite those who are or may be interested in doing the Alpha course or who simply need to see that Christians can have fun!

C2 Connecting Course

This short course gives you a bird's eye view of Mariners' life and culture. It's a chance to learn more about Mariners' 'beating heart' (e.g. history, vision and values, how to get involved, etc).

The course is for you if you are new to Mariners and you are thinking about coming regularly. It is also for you if you have been at Mariners for a while but have never done the Connecting course! The evening consists of a really good meal (don't eat before you come!), a presentation, Q&A and a chance for discussion at tables facilitated by church leaders.

C3 Your Kingdom Come (living as citizens in God's Kingdom)

Our vision statement at Mariners is 'God's Kingdom Come'. When Jesus the King comes, He brings His kingdom with Him. Jesus is also the saviour, saving the lost, healing the sick and setting the tormented or oppressed free. This course is aimed at helping you discover life in all its fullness.

This exciting new discipleship course is for you if you are hungry to discover the full reality of life as a citizen in God's Kingdom and how we can help others become citizens too. On the course, you will (among other things):

- Discover the nature of God's Kingdom and how we become citizens of it
- Learn to think differently as Kingdom citizens

- Learn to live differently by exercising faith and your God given authority, leading others into the Kingdom and praying for healing and freedom.

Delegates will be in groups for discussion time each week. These groups will remain the same each week, giving you the chance to form good and trusted friendships where we hope you will feel able to share more openly. F1 'Remember the poor'

The Apostle Paul said, 'All they asked was that we should continue to remember the poor, the very thing that I was eager to do all along' (Galatians 2:10).

In this group, you will look at:

- Our biblical remit for working with the poor.
- Working with the poor - how to care, yet avoid the pitfalls.
- Trussell Trust's Foodbank ministry and other similar ministries.
- How Trussell Trust started and is developing beyond the provision of a food programme.
- How we can help and support Gloucester foodbank through, for example, prayer, volunteering at the Foodbank, supermarket collections and facilitating a Mariners' food collection.
- Having some fun - and maybe even some food!

So, there will be Bible teaching, discussion, prayer, interactive training on working with the poor and – for those available during the day – a visit to Gloucester foodbank.

F2 Refugee Action and Support

The needs of migrants in Europe and refugees/asylum seekers in the UK are all around us and are increasing. Together, we can do more! As a

group we will be gleaning information, planning, acting, encouraging and praying. In particular, we will be liaising with GARAS (Gloucestershire Action for Refugees and Asylum Seekers) to provide practical help to refugee families arriving in Gloucester in the near future.

On some weeks (between 4-8pm Wednesdays), we will be joining the World café at Brunswick Baptist church, Southgate Street, for food and friendship with people newly arrived in the country and city.
