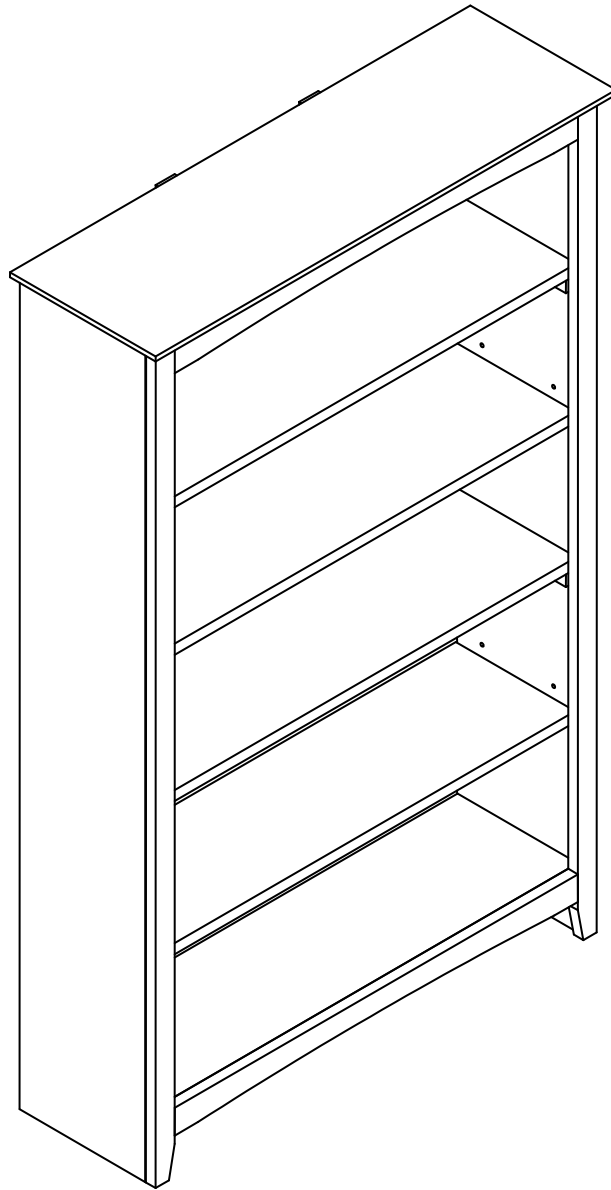

Prior to beginning assembly, however, make sure all parts and hardware are included and free of obvious defect. If a part is missing or defective, please contact the store where purchased. IMPORTANT NOTE:

- Place all wooden parts on a clean and smooth surface such as a rug or carpet to avoid the parts from being scratched.
- Remove all wrapping material, including staples & packing straps before you start to assemble.
- DO NOT tighten all screws and bolts until completely assembled.
- Keep all hardware parts out of reach of children.

STEP 1

Attach side panels (B) to the top (A), and shelf panels (D) and bottom panel (C) with bolts (1), and washers (2) and (3) as shown below. Tighten with Allen key (11).

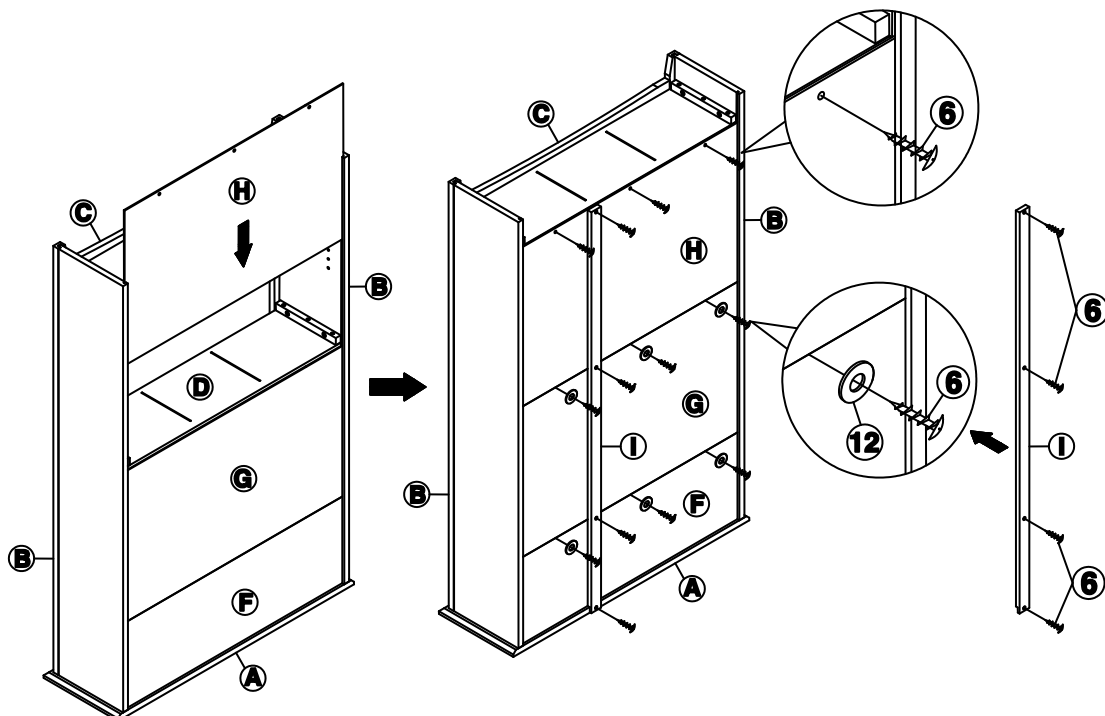


STEP 2

Slide back panels (F), and (G) and (H) into the grooves as shown below.

Attach back panels (F), and (G) and (H) to the unit with pan head screws (6) and washers (12). Tighten with a screwdriver.

Attach connectors (I) to the unit with pan head screws (6) as shown below. Tighten with a screwdriver.



STEP 3

Attach brackets (4) to the unit as shown below. Then place shelves (E) on the brackets and attach with screws (5). Tighten with the screwdriver.

Attach brackets (9) to the back of the unit with screws (7) through the smaller holes in the brackets as shown below.

Important!

Properly attach the other brackets (9) to the wall in an area of ***drywall or plaster with a wood stud***: Mark the attachment point(s) with a pencil at the appropriate height **positioned over the wood stud(s) in the wall**.

Place the unit into position so both mounting brackets are vertically in line.

Properly attach the other brackets (9) to the wall stud with screws (8) through the smaller holes as shown below.

Lace the end of flat nylon ties (10) through the larger holes in each mounting bracket. Bring both ends together and slide the flat ends through the locking ends and draw it through until all slack is removed.

Confirm that the strap is securely laced and locked.
