




At the time of its release, there were only two accepted body styles on the market. If you take a look now, most guitars being produced owe their origin to the Soloist. It was the first guitar design to square up the edges of the body and extend the cutaways for better access to the upper frets.

Because of its neck thru body construction, the Soloist offers very even string response and exceptional sustain, along with unsurpassd solidness and rigidity.

Designed in collaboration with the late Randy Rhoads, this uniquely shaped instrument is still the choice of "Metal" guitarists around the world. The Rhoads guitar was the first instrument produced to bear the Jackson name and it still remains as the flagship of our line. With its unique tone and solid feel, the Rhoads Pro has become one of the few modern guitars already acknowledged as a contemporary classic.

For 1992, we have introduced a new bolt on neck version to make the Rhoads more accessible to guitarists on a limited budget. The Rhoads EX has the same lightening fast neck shape and sonic roar as the original Rhoads Pro.
