I. Prepare for Your Presentation

- Make sure that you have copies of the Foundations Discipleship Workshops page to hand out to the pastors and leaders

- Take time to prepare your testimony of how Foundations has impacted your church.
 - Share specifically how implementing these workshops has helped you as a pastor minister to more people by making multiplying disciples.

II. Recruiting Presentation

1. Welcome and Introductions
 - Let those attending know that you will have time at the end to answer any questions.
2. Share your testimony of how Foundations has impacted your church.
 - Your testimony matters!
3. Jesus gave us a mission and a plan: Multiply disciples and finish the Great Commission!
 - A disciple becomes like Jesus (Romans 8:29)
 - A disciple makes other disciples (Matthew 28:19)
4. When we look at the timeline of the Great Commission, we see that Jesus actually gave the Great Commission **five** times in each of the Gospels and in Acts.
 - These were the last words of Jesus
 - The Great Commission includes both evangelism **and** discipleship. Both are essential if we want to see our churches be faithful to follow what Jesus commanded us to do.
5. Jesus' plan to finish the Great Commission is to **multiply** disciples.
 - Jesus modeled it for us in His life and ministry (John 20:21)
 - Jesus → Twelve Disciples → Obedient Christians (Disciples) → All Nations
 - Jesus modeled for us a plan where disciples multiply disciples, not programs
 - Paul demonstrates Jesus' model in his charge to Timothy (2 Timothy 2:2)
 - Paul → Timothy → Faithful Men (Disciples) → Others Also
 - Paul's missionary journeys demonstrate to us the power of multiplication that can only happen as a result of a movement of multiplying disciples!
6. Foundations is not a program. It is an invitation for each of us as pastors and leaders to align our ministries to Jesus' plan for finishing the Great Commission.
 - You will receive a discipleship curriculum that is free and will make multiplying disciples in your church.
 - You will receive training through four one-day workshops that will equip you and your leaders in:
 - How to grow your church through personal discipleship (Workshop 1)
 - How to manage your life and focus on personal spiritual growth (Workshop 2)
 - How to study the Bible and preach effective lessons (Workshop 3)
 - How to plant new churches and reach your country for Christ (Workshop 4)
7. Let's look at what we will learn together in Workshop 1 because it is the core workshop in how to have a ministry of multiplication through discipleship:
 - The Great Commission
 - Our Response to the Great Commission
 - Foundations Discipleship Plan
 - Multiply Disciples by Apprenticeship
 - How to Lead Foundations

8. Foundations Discipleship Material

- Consists of a “Foundations Leader Training Guide” to train apprentices how to lead Foundations and four sections to the Foundations Discipleship Bible Study Material: Come, Grow, Serve, Go
- It is intended to take a year to 18 months to complete.
- Discipleship happens up close, personal, and over time. Therefore, the material is designed to be used in the context of personal relationships.
- It is designed to be interactive through questions and searching the Scriptures for the answers. It is not meant to be used in a lecture format.
- The Foundations Discipleship Material is free and is available at foundationsglobal.com.

9. What will this training cost you:

- Time to attend the workshops
- The cost to reproduce materials (if your training center is using printed materials; if using digital materials there is no materials cost)
- Any transportation, food or lodging expenses (some churches serve a lunch and provide coffee and snacks and ask for a donation to cover the cost)
- Some training centers take an offering to help cover the costs of the trainer.
- Note: Ask the training center ahead of time what the expenses are and how you can cover them.
 - Your church may choose to cover the cost of your training. This will demonstrate generosity to other churches that will receive the training.
 - If the training center is nearby, there may be little or no expense to the trainer.
- Note: While many training centers choose to do each workshop in one day, it can also be divided into shorter segments and taught over several days.
- Note: Remember the goals for each training center is 20 pastors being trained in 4 workshops over 18 months. Communicate this clearly with the leaders in the recruitment presentation.
