





### Categories from the Profit & Loss report


1 Line performing better than expected

There is a very handy dashboard for the spreadsheet. It displays some vital figures and shows the comparison for the previous year. You can see at a glance how you're comparing to the last year, and also how you are doing with relation to the targets you set yourself from each of the categories you determined. The dashboard doesn't only show this, but also displays any warnings from the data tab.

This tab updates automatically, and provides an excellent 'bird's eye' view of the data.



Each bank entry has a description line, and each one can be over-ridden. So for example, if you have a specific supplier, they will always show up as such. This report will isolate the data for a specific entry name (supplier, staff, etc) as per your bank statement data. This is very handy if you wish to see how your purchases from a specific supplier compare to the last year. This is not based on the category, but the name on the bank statement (or at least what you have labelled it as).



This report is the same as the above report, but this time the data is filtered by the category. These are the categories that you can determine, and where you assign all the bank statement lines. This is very useful to see how your sales, wages, stock, or any other category compares from one year to the next. As you always aim to have a full year and the current year's data, these reports can help to show up unknown rises in costs, as well as show seasonal sales etc.



This is the last report, and it is also largely automated. All you need to do is make some selections. This let's you select any category (or categories) as well as a date range. It then uses only the relevant data to produce a report to show how you've done this year compared to last. For example, if you want to include stock and P&P compared to the sales to determine your margin, you can do so here.


