

# Go Green! 5 Collaborative Project Ideas

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How can you make your lessons more meaningful? How can your students use Green Screen to demonstrate their learning? Using Green Screen in the classroom is easy, economical and appropriate for all grade levels and subject areas!

## What is “green screening”?

Chroma key compositing, or chroma keying, is a special effects / post - production technique for compositing two images or video streams together based on color hues.

Green Screen allows you to create a video using an image or video for your background. If your students are studying about musical instruments, they can create a video report with instrument in the background. What about a report on the instrument families of the orchestra from the middle of the trumpet section or the view of the conductor? The possibilities are endless, so let's get started!
