**ESTABLISHMENT OF A WORKING GROUP ON JURISDICTIONAL CERTIFICATION OF  
PALM OIL IN SERUYAN DISTRICT**

**SERUYAN DISTRICT HEAD**

- Considering : a. that palm oil is a flagship commodity and the largest contributor to Seruyan District's Regional Gross Domestic Product (RGDP) for 2013-2018 established in Seruyan District Regulation (PERDA) Number 4 Year 2014 on Seruyan District Mid-Term Development Plan (RPJMD) and to achieve Sustainable Plantation Management as referred to in Central Kalimantan Provincial Regulation Number 5 Year 2011, the Seruyan District Government promotes the implementation of an approach to jurisdictional certification of palm oil commodity;
- b. that to ensure that the activity is carried out well, it is necessary to establish a Working Group;
- c. that for the reasons as referred to in letters a and b, it is necessary to establish a Seruyan District Head Decree on Establishment of a Working Group on Jurisdictional Certification of Palm Oil in Seruyan District.

HAS DECIDED:

To establish :

ONE : A Working Group on Jurisdictional Certification of Palm Oil is

established in Seruyan District to include elements from the Seruyan District Government, Land Office, Seruyan District Branch GAPKI, Plantation Companies, Indigenous Institutions, Non-Governmental Organizations and *Yayasan Penelitian Inovasi Bumi* (INOBU) as contained in the Annex hereto;

- TWO : The Working Group on Jurisdictional Certification of Palm Oil in Seruyan District is tasked with:
1. Preparing a work plan and resources needed to support Jurisdictional Certification of Palm Oil in the District;
  2. Giving input to support Jurisdictional Certification of Palm Oil in Seruyan District;
  3. Giving input into the development of quick and appropriate ways of reducing frequent risks facing palm oil smallholders and companies, including deforestation, social conflict, greenhouse gas emissions and destruction of areas of high conservation value and high carbon value;
  4. Taking other operational measures related to Jurisdictional Certification of Palm Oil.
- THREE : The operations of the Working Group on Jurisdictional Certification of Palm Oil in Seruyan District shall be financially supported by the Seruyan District Budget and other clear and legal sources;
- FOUR : This Decree comes into effect on the date of its establishment, provided that, in response to some new future matters not covered herein, the decree shall be subject to proper amendment and revision.
