

RIVER CROSSING



Overview

This is a team building game for your whole group. Split your group into equal teams. Using tape mark two banks on either side of a gym, large room or outside. The space between the banks is the river and students can not touch the ground. Students must use supplies given to get their whole team across the river.

How to Play

1. Divided your group into Equal Teams
2. Using tape or cones mark two banks on either side of your gym, large room or outside.
3. Give each group a random assortment of supplies they can stand on, pull or use in anyway to get everyone across the river. Random small items are great. You want to choose things that may get destroyed.
4. Students race to get everyone across the space without anyone touching the floor.
5. If anyone on a team touches the floor they must go back to the first bank and start over.
6. The first team with everyone across the space is the winner.

Supplies

1. Tape to mark the banks.
2. Random supplies for each team to walk on.

Pro Tip

1. Make sure you have a leader with every group to point out when a student touches the ground.
2. Make sure each group has the same type of random items.
3. To make the game harder have one student start on the opposite end with a rope and give each team less supplies. The one student will have to throw out a rope and pull each student across on a blanket or cushion.
